However, we are also able to offer new services, such as a shopping service for families, or those in villas, or indeed anyone who wants to lighten their luggage! We can arrange a special day trip on a gulet or dinner in a favourite restaurant, birthday surprise of cakes, wine, chocolates or simply personal parking at your departure airport. Whatever it is we will do our very best to meet all your requirements. Just ask us to arrange it for you, we will enjoy the challenge.

Below are just a few of the many ways in which our Concierge Service Team can help you reduce the stress so often associated with the planning of your holiday. However, we are happy to try to help in any way you wish.

BEFORE YOU DEPART

Travel Insurance (see page 127)

Whilst we do not insist you take our insurance you must be insured, even the best laid plans can go awry and its always best to be prepared, otherwise it can be costly if suddenly you need to cancel or worse you fall ill on holiday. Rock Insurance is able to offer two covers, either standard or premium cover and arrange excess waiver for a small additional charge, so no excess will have to be paid in the event of a claim.

Towels

What and what not to take in your luggage, with some airlines reducing your baggage allowance, packing is becoming one of the holiday nightmares. However, you don't have to worry about packing beach towels, as we will supply them, with our compliments.

Your Flying Comfort

Most airlines offer the ability to pre-book your seats together as well as extra leg room seats, though you must be able-bodied and no children are allowed in these seats. All airlines charge for these services at varying costs from approximately £5 per person for sitting together, with extra leg room seats from around £15 per person one way.

Likewise, most airlines now charge for the privilege of having an airline meal! We can advise you of this at the time you book and it will show you on your tickets or itinerary whether a meal is included on the flight. Where applicable, we can make special dietary requests for your in-flight meals.

DEPARTURE

We are delighted to be working with Meteor Meet and Greet, a company with more than 20 years experience. Like us they believe the guest comes first and will ensure that any stress associated with parking your car is reduced by their exemplary service.

A friendly, uniformed and professional member of their team will meet you at the terminal, so no more transfer buses and struggling with luggage, you simply drive straight to your terminal.

Secure parking

Your car will be taken to one of their secure car parks, all of which have been accredited with the safer parking award, for the duration of your holiday.

Convenience

This service is available at any time no matter what time your flight departs or arrives.

Prices

Vary depending on the month, but are very competitive and we have some great offers for those that book early.

Airport Parking

For those that prefer to park their own car and for those airports where we are unable to offer our Meet and Greet service, we can arrange secure parking both on and off the airport. All the car parks we use are accredited with the safer parking award so you can rest assured your car is securely parked whilst you are on holiday.

Airport Assistance

For anyone requiring assistance at the airport please do let us know, we have a form that we will ask you to fill in asking certain questions, this will help us arrange the correct level of assistance with your relevant airline. It will also help us in ensuring you have booked a suitable holiday and offer any assistance in resort for you on arrival and during your holiday.

There are help points in all the UK airports which connect you to someone that can offer you assistance in getting to the check-in. If you have requested airport assistance with ourselves this will be communicated to the airline and will be from the check-in. They will arrange for either a wheelchair or one of the motorised buggies to take you to the boarding gate.

The arrival airports in Turkey and Greece are not quite as organised, but then they are not quite as large as their UK counterparts. It is possible to arrange wheelchair assistance although the airports are smaller, however if you do require help then again this can be arranged.

Airport Lounges

The ultimate way to while away the time between check-in and boarding. Families are welcome in a number of the lounges but not all, just check with us. There are a number of different lounges, some accepting children, some adult only. But they are a perfect place to escape from all the noise and chaos of the airport terminal. They all offer, unlimited beverages, (soft and alcoholic – not champagne!), snacks and complimentary newspapers in a relaxing lounge atmosphere. Prices start at around £13.50 per person.

ARRIVAL AT YOUR HOLIDAY DESTINATION

Private Transfers (see page 126)

All our holidays include transfers between the airport and property, (except car inclusive properties in Greece). If you would prefer either or indeed both legs of the journey to be made by private transfer, we can arrange for an air-conditioned car or minibus to meet you and take you to and from the front door of your hotel or villa.

Car Hire (see page 124)

Access to a car gives you the opportunity to explore your surroundings at leisure and is especially useful for those properties that are 'off the beaten track'. If you would like to hire a car during your holiday, we can arrange for you to pick one up from the airport, or have it delivered to your door. Alternatively just hire it for a few days.

TRAVELLING WITH CHILDREN

Baby Packages (Turkey)

With the ever increasing changes in security and luggage restrictions, we understand it is becoming more difficult to carry all the usual paraphernalia for babies and young children. Also it's simply not feasible to take everything, though ensuring your little ones have something to play with, sit on and be safe in, is of the utmost importance to you especially on holiday. We have put together a number of 'packages' we believe will suit most families to include the hire of items such as: car seats, cots, play mats, sterilisers and bottles.

In addition we are offering a bespoke shopping service so you don't have to fill your luggage with nappies and wipes.

Childrens clubs

Whilst in Turkey none of our hotels offer childrens clubs, the friendly nature of all the hotels ensures families are more than welcome. But for those looking for a little more organised 'play' for their little ones we suggest you look at Crete. Both the St Nicholas Bay Hotel and the Istron Bay Hotel have a 'Childrens Club' for children aged 4 –11 with English speaking supervisor six days a week without charge. They also offer, childrens menus with early dining, high chairs, complimentary baby cots and baby food and facilities on request. Babysitting is also available at a supplement.

Private Nanny Service/Babysitting

Let us know if you would like to have a nanny or babysitter to assist you during your holiday and we will endeavour to find a suitable nanny to meet your requirements. Our English speaking nannies/babysitters are not necessarily qualified but will be experienced in childcare and are capable of taking sole charge.

SHOPPING SERVICES

Villas

On arrival in your villa, you will receive a small welcome hamper which will include a few items which we regard as a necessity! A bottle of wine, a bottle of water, some tea bags, coffee, milk, bread and cheese. Just enough to stave off a thirst or hunger pang! However, we are happy to offer a shopping service and can do an initial shop for you so that you have supplies in your villa from the day you arrive. We will provide you with a list of produce that can be purchased in our areas and you simply tell us what you would like to buy. If you prefer to go shopping yourself but would like assistance, we can provide you with a personal shopper who has local product knowledge and a car to carry it all home in!

Villas and Hotels

We can supply other items such as suntan creams and after sun lotions, we can provide you with a list of the products available in resort and we can buy them and have them in your room on arrival. Likewise if there is anything else you would like us to purchase for you on arrival just ask!

Lazy days at Sea – Limited to eight guests, our boat cruises out of Kalkan harbour and around the bays for a relaxing day at sea.

Its possible to book the whole boat for yourselves or a group of friends for the day, or an evening or indeed overnight.

Private trip to Ephesus – our guide will take your personal group, be it just the two of you or more. Likewise we can offer Arycanda/Elmali as a one day private tour.

In Crete our agents offer a variety of jaunts – details can be requested or provided on your arrival.

Watersports

Most of our resorts offer watersports, and diving, for further details specific for your chosen destination then simply call the Tapestry Collection Concierge on 020 8996 3580.

Beauty Treatments and Spa Facilities

For a little indulgence and extra relaxation, there are many treatments on offer at the Asfiya Wellness Spa (Kalkan only) which we can book for you. The Likya Residence and Spa, (new hotel opening 2008 – Kalkan) will also be offering prebookable Spa facilities.

Other hotels such as the St Nicholas Bay Hotel in Crete also offer these facilities.

RESTAURANT BOOKING SERVICE

We are happy to offer a restaurant booking service as especially in the high season they do get very booked up. (Kalkan, Fethiye and Fiscardo only). If you have travelled with us previously you probably have your favourites and we will be happy to book any of your choice. Or, if you tell us what you like we are happy to recommend, these recommendations are made from the feedback we receive from our guests and we would like to advise that Tapestry Collection do not receive any commission from restaurants in any of our resorts.

All of our hotels also offer the facility to book a meal at their restaurant, at a special price, for the night of your arrival. If you would like to book this service, the details are on the relevant hotel page or just call the Tapestry Collection Concierge on 020 8996 3580.

Inspirational IDEAS

We have many guests who call us to ask our advice when they are deciding on which property to choose for their holiday. Within our team we have a wide knowledge of all our resorts and properties so providing you can give us some guidance as to the type of holiday experience you are searching for then we will certainly come up with some ideas for you.

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View over Ölü Deniz lagoon

If you are undecided between two different properties or, indeed, two different resorts, don't forget it is possible to have both by choosing a split centre holiday. This is especially popular if guests are choosing a gulet holiday, as we would highly recommend a week on land in one of our hotels before boarding the gulet, or vice versa.

The list of split centres is endless. You can pick a combination of any of the properties in our brochures, as we are able to arrange transfers between all of them. The norm would be to choose properties that are in the same destination, for instance, a week in Kaya Valley and then a week in Kalkan.

To price these split centres:

Take both two week prices and divide by 2, then simply add on a private transfer between the two resorts (for private transfer prices please see page 126).

But if you are feeling particularly adventurous (as a number of our guests did last year) it is even possible to take a week between Crete and Kefalonia! These are slightly more complicated to price as they involve internal flights so simply call us.

Listed on the following pages is a small selection of some appetising samples of split centres.

Tersane sole charter (pages 82-83) combined with Villa Alev (pages 20-21) up to ten guests

A fantastic way to holiday with friends or family by cruising the southwest coast of Turkey on board the Tersane on your own private charter before staying in a private five bedroom villa with swimming pool and Jacuzzi in the picturesque harbour town of Kalkan.

Example of price (holiday as above based in June from Gatwick):

Add both two week prices for the Alev and the Tersane and divide by 2:

2 week stay on Tersane £1730 per person for first 2 guests	= £3460
2 weeks Alev £1100 per person for first 2 guests	= £2200
Add the 2 prices together	= £5660
Divide by 2	= £2830 (Total: first 2 guests)
Tersane £600 per person for extra guests (x8)	= £4800
Alev £500 per person for extra guests (x8)	= £4000
Add the 2 prices together	= £8800
Divide by 2	= £4400 (Total: remaining guests)

Add the two totals together Total £7230 (Total holiday cost)

Based on ten guests this works out at £723 per person, the only extra cost to add on would be the split centre transfer if you had to travel to Fethiye to join the gulet, all other transfers are included.

Villa Damla (pages 26-27) and Villa Olivia (pages 28-29) and Tersane (pages 82-83) up to twelve guests

The two villas are next door to each other and each has four bedrooms all with en suite facilities, and a swimming pool. They are a short walk into Kalkan and an ideal location for two families or groups of friends, so spend a week here and then board the Tersane for your second week at sea, or vice versa.

Two night Mini-Cruise

If you're not sure you want to spend a full week at sea, why not just take a short mini-cruise and spend two nights aboard our gulet Julian based in Kalkan. It sleeps just ten, but it's possible to take it yourselves or with a few friends or, alternatively, just book a cabin.

Embark on Sunday morning to fresh coffee and pastries before the gulet leaves the harbour. The cruise will take you out of the bay of Kalkan and around to the bays of Kekova and Kas with the highlight being a stop in Meis a small Greek island opposite Kas. The mini-cruise will include a simple Turkish lunch, afternoon tea and a lovely dinner on board, on both Sunday and Monday night. The gulet will meander back into Kalkan port on Tuesday after lunch. A fantastic way to relax and top up your tan and hopefully give you an appetite to try a weeks gulet cruise next year! Please call our Reservations team on 020 8995 7787 for prices.



Emelisse Hotel in Fiscardo, Kefalonia (pages 108-109) and St Nicolas Bay Hotel in Agios Nikolaos, Crete (pages 90-91)

It is possible to combine both these Greek islands though, depending on flight availability, it is likely to mean an overnight stop at Athens airport. Though with the Sofitel hotel, right on the airport, this makes it very easy to do. Both of these hotels offer a very high standard of accommodation and a fabulous way to see both islands.

Two or three nights in Cirali, 20 minutes from Olympos

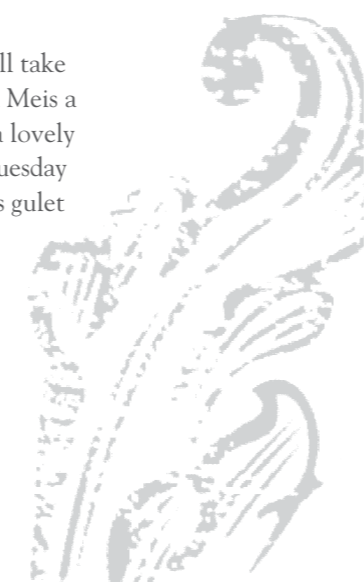
Cirali is world famous for the Chimaera, Lycia's eternal fire an extraordinary natural phenomenon. It also has a long sandy beach which is one of the few protected beaches where the loggerhead turtles can lay their eggs. It is situated approximately three hours drive from Kalkan and is a million miles away in terms of similarity! Cirali is perfect for a few days of peace and tranquillity away from it all, and an ideal place to stay to visit the Chimaera, Olympos and its ruins. However, the accommodation is much more simple but fine for a couple of nights. We can arrange a transfer for you to Cirali and back again, though we suggest you take car hire so you can travel at your own leisure and once there can visit Olympos and the Chimaera as you please. Prices for three nights in a small hotel in Cirali start at £245, this is for two guests and includes car hire.

Where East meets West

Combine a few days in Istanbul seeing the sights before heading down on a domestic flight to the coastal region for a more relaxing few days. The majority of the cultural and historic sites are in the Old City, the Blue Mosque with its 21,000 hand painted tiles, the Haghia Sophia and the Tokapi Palace to name a few and so we suggest staying in the Sultan Ahmet region giving you easy access to these sights and to the nightlife. There are great restaurants, a huge variety of shops as well as the Grand Bazaar and a lively café music scene to keep you busy for at least two or three days.

Team this up with a week or so on the coast and you have an ideal holiday for those who like a little bit more than just relaxing in the sunshine.

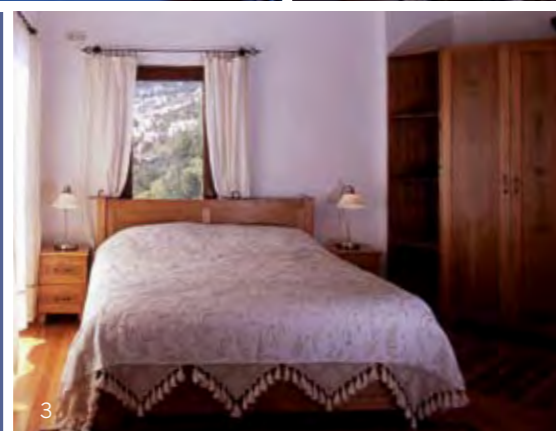

From the spacious open plan sitting and dining room, wander onto the airy terrace overlooking a further attraction, the eye catching infinity pool.

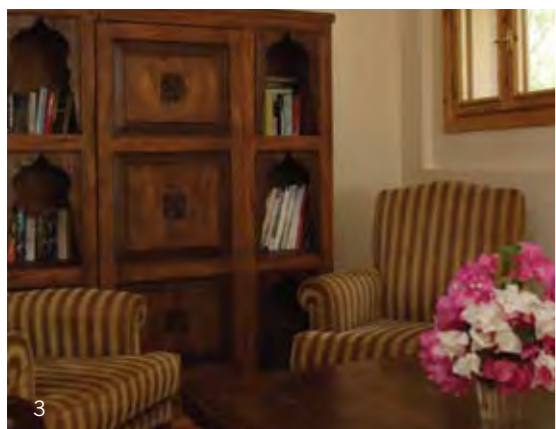

villa alev

Luxurious five bedroom villa close to Kalkan harbour with beautiful sea views from the large poolside terrace that features a private swimming pool and Jacuzzi.

Villa Alev has been a favourite with our guests for a few years now and there's no sign of that changing. Part of its charm is that it's decorated to a high standard without losing that personal touch, as owners Metin and Paula use it as their private home during the winter. There's been no stinting on quality here, particularly in the kitchen, as you would expect of a chef. Having trained at Kendal College in the Lake District, Metin now creates a masterful menu of modern European and Turkish dishes at Zeki's, the restaurant he and Paula established in the Old Town.

Carrying on with the culinary theme, there's an abundance of outdoor eating and living spaces in the villa. Just by the entrance there's a cushioned outdoor seating area, the pool terrace dining area seats ten comfortably and there are sea view terraces from the main bedrooms. French windows optimise the views across the bay and outdoors there's a Jacuzzi by the pool which is just the place to relax and take in the scenery too.

The villa – named after the couple's daughter Alev – is spacious and light, with wooden floors and tasteful furnishings. It boasts five bedrooms, four bathrooms and two sitting rooms, along with plenty of outside space, ensuring that as many as ten guests can be accommodated here easily without any sense of restriction. Little extras like satellite TV and DVD make this one of Kalkan's most sought-after villas.

Villa Alev is ideal for large groups and with an ambience made for entertaining, it's a place where you'll enjoy long, lazy meals with one of Kalkan's finest views as a backdrop. If you want to walk off your latest indulgence, then the Old Town is only a 15 minute stroll away, but if you like life to be even easier, Paula and Metin will arrange to deliver food and drink fresh from the restaurant for you – it doesn't get much better than that!

villa hosgör

Positioned above an extensive swimming pool, the Villa Hosgör sits in the heart of the mountains of Islamlar and is a traditional, rustic villa that has beautiful views of the surrounding mountains.

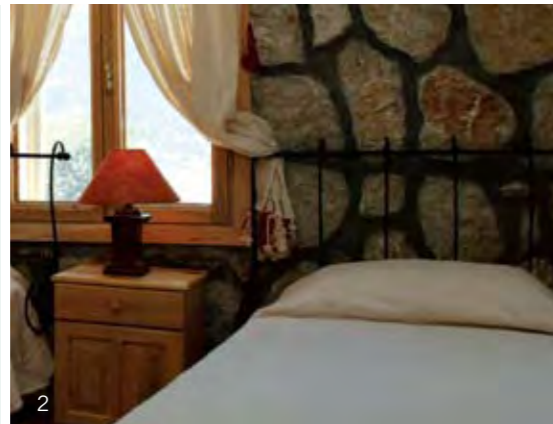

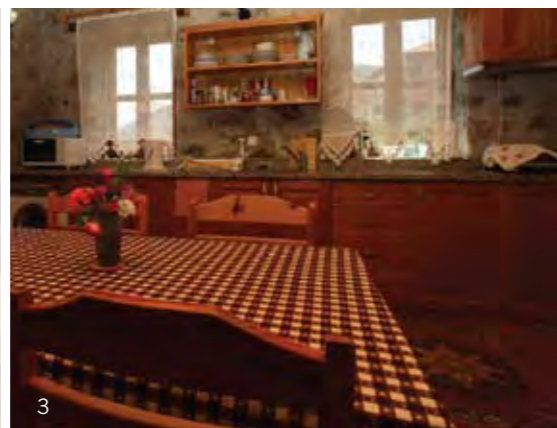
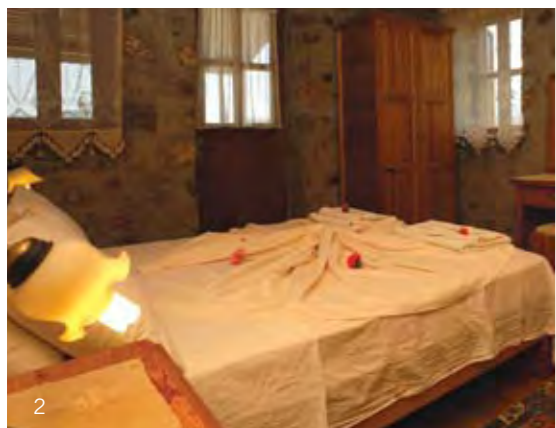

akinci evi

A traditional villa situated in the heart of Kaya Valley, the Akinci Evi is a unique property in keeping with the history of its surroundings.

When arriving at Akinci Evi, your eye will naturally be drawn to the lovely terraced gardens and the large pool.

The property itself is very individual, partly because of the building, with wooden floors and high ceilings, and partly because of the antique furniture in the villa. This was brought from Rhodes in 1923 by the family's grandmother who moved to Turkey under the same population exchange that led to Kaya being abandoned.

özlem evi

New for 2008 this charming property has marvellous views of the Kaya Valley ruins and with its lovely pool and garden it is sure to be extremely popular with our guests.

Set literally at the foot of the famous ghost village, Özlem Evi is a simple Turkish stone villa built typically in keeping with its natural surroundings.

It is built all on one level and you enter into the hall, leading off this are the two bedrooms to the left, one with en suite facilities. On the right hand side you have a shower/wc, open plan kitchen and lounge area which leads out onto the large terrace from which you can take in the views of the ghost village, only a stones throw away from where you are sitting.

A path leads down to the good sized pool which gets sun most of the day but there are plenty of places to escape the mid-day sun in the extensive gardens including the Turkish seating or kosk area.

It is only a matter of minutes through the fields if you want to walk in to the centre of Kaya and from here there are numerous other paths you can take to wander round the ghost village or the Kaya Valley or for the more adventurous, follow part of the Lycian Way over the mountains for the 2 hours 30 minutes walk down to the beach at Ölü Deniz taking in the magnificent views as you go. Should you want to venture further afield in the car provided you have Gemiler beach 15 minutes away and Fethiye only a 20 minutes drive away.

Slightly off the beaten track the attraction of this villa is the peace, its surroundings and the views out over the ghost village from the terrace and gardens. It's a perfect place to forget about every day hassles and concentrate on relaxing!

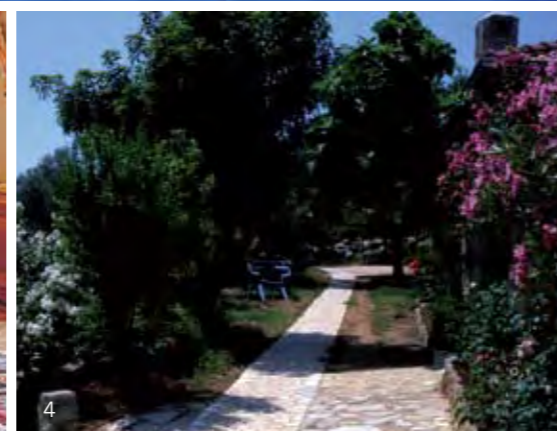
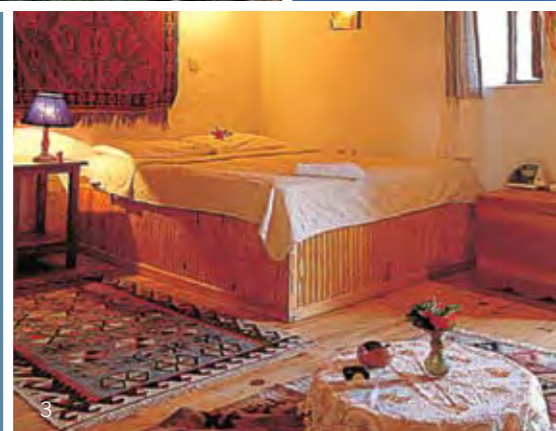

ocakköy

With views of Hisaronu in the distance and on the outskirts of Fethiye and Ölü Deniz is Ocakköy, a former working Turkish village positioned in enormous grounds with the luxury of three swimming pools.

Situated on a hillside midway between the ghost village of Kaya Valley and the market town of Fethiye, Ocakköy is a collection of carefully renovated village houses set in enormous mature grounds, where the overriding feeling is of space and tranquillity. The superb views stretch across the plains and the mountains into the distance giving you a taste of the stunning scenery that is all around you.

Ocakköy's history goes back to the eleventh century. The cottages and buildings that formed the village were abandoned around 1918 and in recent years renovated into thirty stone cottages, four one bedroom apartments and eight hotel rooms

The cottages and rooms are simple but have been restored with lots of character, furnished and decorated in the traditional Ottoman style, each one with its own terrace area covered in bougainvillea and the natural flora and fauna around it. The property blends perfectly with its surroundings rather than dominating them. Each morning and afternoon you will see the locals take their goats and cows up to the hills and back again and obviously in such natural surroundings it's not surprising one sees all manner of creepy crawlies!

The convenient location puts Fethiye, Kaya and Ölü Deniz within easy reach, either by dolmus from the main road, or by hire car. This means Ocakköy is a great choice for families, offering the best of both worlds – beaches and a little hustle and bustle when desired, with the peaceful property always there to return to.

A seven cabin gulet of the highest standard coupled with exceptional service; at a generous thirty-two metres in length it is perfect for sailing enthusiasts and sole charters alike.

The word “gulet” derives from the French schooner or goulette, usually made from local pine these two mastered wooden vessels were used for transport and fishing along the coasts of southern Turkey. Designed with a sharp bow and a broad beam these days they are designed with comfort rather than trade in mind.

Tersane (meaning shipyard) is thirty-two metres in length but has only seven cabins creating much more space than usual, both in the cabins and in the shared areas. All seven cabins are doubles with a seating area, en suite shower/wc and air-conditioning

On our itineraries Tersane tends to motor for most of the journey to keep to the schedule that weather and time permit. However the sails can be used at the Captain's discretion. There are ample opportunities to swim, canoe, snorkel and fish in the many secluded bays.

The feedback from guests in 2007 is that the food, service and crew was unbeatable with many Tapestry Collection guests booking this gulet year on year.

agios nikolaos

This fashionable and quite sophisticated town named after St Nicholas is built around a small sweetwater lake. Local urban legend has it that Voulismeni Lake is bottomless and that the goddess Athena once bathed in its waters but, tales aside, the lakeside waterfront is in reality the vibrant heart of the town. In the summer months, there are open-air theatre performances by its shores and al fresco restaurants abound.

Those looking for a little culture will enjoy the Archaeological Museum, with pieces dating back to the Minoan period, or the seventh-century Byzantine church, with its fine frescoes above the entrance. If your tastes run a little more towards shopping, there's a superb selection of boutiques, with handcrafted jewellery, textiles and traditional artwork. For a quiet stroll, the fishing harbour is a popular spot to catch the sunset, often followed by a pre-dinner drink in one of the harbourside bars. The town's restaurants range from relaxed to stylish and lively, so you'll be spoilt for choice when deciding where to dine.

A stay in Agios Nikolaos can offer you the best of both worlds – all the sophistication of a bustling harbour town with an easy escape into the nearby countryside. The beautiful unspoilt village of Krista is only a 10km drive away or you can take the ferry to Agios Pandes, a nature reserve in the bay, nicknamed Kri-Kri Island by the locals after the rare wild goats that inhabit it.

elounda and plaka

The most exclusive hotels in Crete are found in the low-key location of Elounda, on the clear turquoise waters of a lagoon that's said to be home to a mermaid goddess. She's not the lagoon's only secret – on days when the waters are calm you can see the walls of the lost city of Olos beneath the waves. There's a slow pace of life here, so some may wonder why it has attracted the crème de la crème of luxury hotels, but the views across Mirabello Bay to the Sitia Mountains are enough to justify the choice.

The town has a large village square lined with cafés, restaurants and shops, while a bank, post office and bakery are all nearby. Two windmill towers, missing their blades, stand by the causeway to Spinalonga and if you look carefully you'll find a dolphin-filled mosaic a short walk away, that's all that remains of a ruined Byzantine basilica.

Spinalonga Island lies at the entrance of Elounda Bay and boat trips run out to it half-hourly in peak season. Its Venetian fortress was once a refuge for Christians fleeing from the Turks, before it became a leper colony known as the 'Isle of Tears'.

The quiet hamlet of Plaka lies just 5km to the north. Little more than just a cluster of classically Greek whitewashed houses with blue shutters nestling on a pebbled cove, Plaka is home to some surprisingly good fish tavernas. Elounda locals come to Plaka to get away from it all and enjoy the small, uncrowded beaches. Guests who like to take the road less travelled will enjoy Plaka's simple delights.



istron

Istron Bay comes highly recommended, if its local name of 'Refuge of the Gods' is to be believed. With two of the most beautiful beaches in the region, this quiet little village is an idyllic location for a peaceful and restful holiday. There are only a couple of shops and a sprinkling of cafés, bars and tavernas to distract you from the fabulous views. Should you tire of this total escape from urban life, you can take the local bus services to the towns of Agios Nikolaos or Sita for a touch of shopping or nightlife. One of Istron's more unusual facilities for a small village is a qualified diving instructor based at the Istron Bay Hotel, so curiously it's the perfect location for budding scuba divers.

rethymnon

For a town that's the third largest in Crete, Rethymnon has retained a surprising amount of character and a lingering sleepy air about it. The Old Town remains relatively unchanged, although there's a lively social scene centered around the portside bars and a good selection of shops. Dating back as far as the Mycenaean period, the settlement of Rethymnon has survived the Roman, Byzantine and Ottoman empires, as well as the 16th century Venetian occupation, which has left its architectural mark most strongly.

The harbour is dominated by the Venetian fortress, which is claimed to be the largest ever built. Constructed in 1590 to protect from pirates and Turkish marauders, it was spectacularly unsuccessful. The Turks simply bypassed the Fortezza and took the city within 24 hours. Today it's a cultural centre with an outdoor theatre and the best vantage-point to get a panoramic view of the town.

The town beach is easily found right in the heart of Rethymnon, with showers and cafés, as well as a row of tavernas behind it. Other sights include a Venetian Loggia, the Archaeological Museum, municipal gardens and two mosques converted from a Christian church and a Venetian monastery. The richly-decorated Rimondi fountain can be found in Platanos Square, the centre of the Venetian town.

The surrounding countryside is definitely worth a visit, becoming even more beautiful as you move towards the interior of the island. The remote Monastery of Arkadi became a centre for revolutionaries during the Turkish occupation, due to its inaccessible location. Nowadays it's an easy drive from the more urban delights of Rethymnon town.

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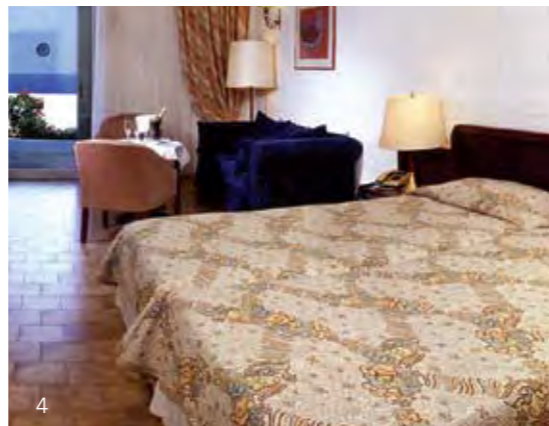

booking conditions

1. BOOKING YOUR HOLIDAY(S)

All holidays are subject to availability. As soon as we have confirmed all aspects of your holiday are available, and we receive £150 deposit per person from you (or you pay your travel agent) plus any insurance premiums your booking is confirmed. (If within 10 weeks of departure, full payment is required). The person whose name the booking is in must be over 18 years old and acts on behalf of all other named persons. Once we have received a payment from you then this constitutes agreement of our booking conditions.

Occasionally the deposits may be increased if we are buying seats in from an outside source whose booking conditions vary from ours. For all bookings made within 8 weeks of departure, the booking is confirmed verbally at the time of booking and subsequently if you cancel or change it, changes as set out in (3) will apply.

2. YOUR INVOICE

You will receive a confirmation invoice from us either by email or post which must be checked carefully. Any mistakes, especially to spelling of names must be advised immediately or at least within 7 days of receipt and we will do our utmost to amend them without any charges. However, charges may be incurred as some charter and scheduled airlines make charges for any changes and we would purely be passing these on.

The confirmation will confirm the date that your full payment is required and reminders will not necessarily be sent.

3. IF YOU CHANGE YOUR HOLIDAY

We will do our utmost to make any changes you request, however, charges will apply dependent on type of change and the date in respect of how close it is to departure.

- i) More than 56 days before departure - £20 per change
- ii) Less than 56 days - Cancellation charges apply

Please note:

- a) To change date, duration or property then the new price will be charged for new holiday as of the date you made your original booking.
- b) If you change one or more names (but not all names), £40 per name change is charged up to 28 days before departure, then cancellation charges apply.

Any cancellation must be notified in writing by the person whose name the holiday is invoiced, by email or post and is actioned and charges will apply from the date we receive the letter.

If the reasons for your cancellation falls within the terms of insurance, you must make a claim direct to your insurance company. Insurance premiums are forfeited on cancellation. If you do not turn up for your flight, your booking will be treated as a cancellation and normal cancellation charges of 100% will be applied. If only part of your party is cancelling this may affect the price of the rest of the booking.

5. OUR PRICE POLICY

The price of your holiday is subject to the possibility of surcharges normally as a result of fuel increases, scheduled airfare increases, taxes, or any other airline cost charges which we have to pay or collect. Also variation in exchange rates or if any government or other regulatory body impose or increase taxes.

If this means paying more than 10% on the holiday price you will be entitled to cancel your holiday with a full refund of all monies except for any insurance premiums paid.

As most airlines operate a fluid pricing system, with fares rising and falling in line with supply and demand, flight supplements and fuel supplements may apply to some flights. The exact supplement (if any) will be advised at the time you confirm your booking.

We reserve the right to correct errors in both advertised and confirmed prices. Should there be an obviously incorrect price shown we will advise you and issue a new invoice and not be bound by the incorrect one. All prices include VAT.

6. IF WE CHANGE OR CANCEL YOUR HOLIDAY.

Our holidays are planned months in advance and whilst it is unlikely we will have to make any changes to confirmed bookings, it can happen. They are usually of a minor nature and we will advise you or your agent at the earliest possible time.

Flight timings, carriers and aircraft type are subject to change, due to the fact that we have no control over these areas and may be varied by Airport Authorities or other factors beyond our control.

Occasionally, we may have to make a 'significant change' for reasons other than 'force majeure', these would be considered:

- Change of departure airport (except between Gatwick, Heathrow and Stansted)
- Change of outward time by more than 12 hours
- Change of accommodation to that of a lower classification (i.e. villa to hotel)
- Change of resort

In which case you would then have a choice of the following:

- Accept the changed arrangements
- Purchase an alternative holiday from us (there may be a difference in price)

Compensation does not apply to changes incurred by 'force majeure', war, threat of war, riots, civil strife, terrorist activity, industrial disputes, natural or nuclear disaster, epidemics, health risks, fire, technical problems to transport, closure or congestion of airspace or airports, cancellation of scheduled airlines or other events outside our control.

7. OUR RESPONSIBILITY

We accept responsibility

- for ensuring your holiday is supplied to you as described on your confirmation and on our website (which will have the up to date information) and to a reasonable standard. If any part of the arrangements are not provided as agreed, we will pay you appropriate compensation as long as you have taken all reasonable steps to notify our staff and mitigate your losses. - for the acts and /or omissions of our employees, agents, and suppliers whilst acting within the scope of or in the course of their employment with us
- for illness, injury or death of any of your party (connected with your holiday arrangements) if its proved to be caused by negligence of our employees, agents or suppliers and you tell the supplier involved at the time and write to us within 3 months of your return. If it's not connected with your holiday arrangements, then we will provide you with all reasonable assistance. This may include, translation services, communication with authorities, help with legal fees, however this must be requested within 90 days of the incident. All assistance is subject to our reasonable discretion and a maximum total cost to ourselves of £5000 per booking. If you receive payment for legal costs and other expenses under any insurance policy, you must repay to us the cost and expense we spend in assisting you

We have done our best to ensure that our brochure is accurate at the time of going to press, however you will appreciate that we do not own the accommodation, airlines or other services and facilities that you will be using and changes may occur.
